ELIGIBILITY

Only the bonafide students from the college and university duly nominated by the Head of the Department are eligible for participation. The application duly recommended by the head of the department of college/ university must reach IBRAD on or before 15th October 2019.

The registered participants will only be allowed to participate in the contest.

REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION FEE

A refundable Registration Fee of Rs. 500/- is to be deposited by cash between 9th-15th October 2019 barring Saturdays and Sundays at the above mentioned office address of IBRAD. Participants can also submit the fee through Demand Draft in favor of Indian Institute of Bio-Social Research and Development payable at Kolkata.

ATTENDANCE

Each contestant must be physically present on both the days of the contest, i.e., on 19th and 20th October 2019. Contestants must report at 10.30 a.m. on the 19th October 2019 to complete the formalities.

REFUND OF THE FEE

The registration fee will be refunded after attendance of the contestants in the National Convention on the 19th and 20th October 2019.

LANGUAGE

Speaker has to deliver the speech in English only.

CONTENT OF THE SPEECH

Contestants must create their own speeches, and each must be substantially original. Any quoted, paraphrased, or referenced content must be acknowledged with due reference during the speech presentation. The contestants must certify in writing during submission of application that the content of their speech will be substantially original.

The speakers should not use any adversarial comments in their speech.

TIME

Speaker has to speak for minimum three minutes and not more than five minutes. Any one continues speaking for less than three minutes or more than five minute 15 seconds will be disqualified.

Contestants must not use digital or other devices during the contest to gain an unfair advantage.

All speeches delivered by the contestants must conform to the timing guidelines for the contest.

FORMAT OF THE CONTEST

All the registered contestant will be given opportunity for presentation in the semi final round to be held on the 19th October 2019 at 4:00PM. A pre convention selection meet will be on the 18th October 2019 at 10,30 a.m.

The Participants are required to get confirmation about the acceptance of their nomination on the 16th October 2019 only.

The final contest with the qualified contestants of the semi final round will be held on the 20th October 2019 at 2:00 PM.

The qualified candidates for the final round must present something new and different in their speech than the one presented during the semifinal round on the 19th October 2019.

AWARD

The best presentation will be awarded with a Gold Medal followed by a silver and bronze Medal in order of merit.

The Panel of Judges reserves the right for final decision regarding the award.

CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION

All the participants who will attend both the days of the National Convention will be awarded a Certificate of Participation.
