Background

The International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples is celebrated across the Globe on the 9th of August. On 23rd December 1994, the United Nations General Assembly through its Resolution 49/214 decided that The International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples will be observed on the 9th of August each year. On this day people from across the world are encouraged to spread the UN message on the protection and promotion of the rights of indigenous peoples.

Theme

The theme for the year 2022 is
“The Role of Indigenous Women in the Preservation and Transmission of Traditional Knowledge”.

Traditional Knowledge and Women

Indigenous peoples account for 6.2 per cent of the global population and in India, the Scheduled Tribe constitutes 8.6% of its total population.

Indigenous women play a crucial role in the preservation and transmission of traditional knowledge and practices. They have an integral role as carers and keepers of the natural resources and their associated knowledge. However, they are often discriminated against, alienated and marginalised from the decision-making process.
